We support approximately 1,500 children annually—those in care, at risk, or aging out—by providing a vital safety net that meets basic needs, fosters stability, and nurtures the whole child.

From clothing and housing support to memory-making experiences and transition services, our holistic approach is designed to help every young person feel seen, supported, and celebrated. Whether a child is entering care with only the clothes on their back or preparing to step into adulthood, we walk alongside them, amplifying their voices, affirming their worth, and helping them rise above adversity with courage and strength.

As we prepare to celebrate our 15th anniversary, this year's theme – Heroes Rising: A Journey of Strength and Hope – honors the resilience of the children we serve and the unwavering community that stands beside them. Together, we are helping every child in foster care not just survive but soar.

Programs & Services

Emergency & Normalcy Needs Program – provides vital support to children in foster care by addressing immediate needs and promoting a sense of stability and normalcy in their lives.

Dream Big Days – offers children in foster care unique and core memory-making experiences designed to foster joy, exploration, and connection.

School Break Food & Wellness Program - bridges the gap for children in foster care by providing nutritious meals, wellness activities, and essential support during out of school time, fostering their overall well-being and resilience.

Fostering Hope - supports youth, ages 15-22 preparing to transition out of the foster care system towards independent living.

Hope Haven – provides essential items and support to children and families in need, promoting empowerment and dignity.

Impact

On any given day, there are nearly 391,000 children in foster care in the United States, with a little over 1,500 children in foster care in Broward County. During FY 24–25, Voices provided tailored support and resources to children in foster care through the following programs:
