

Why Support Voices for Children of Broward County?

The statistics are staggering, but your support makes it possible for **Voices for Children of Broward County (Voices)** to step in when children in foster care need stability, support, and moments of normalcy.

Each year in Broward County, more than **1,200** children live in foster care at some point, and nearly **1,800** children spend time in care over a 12-month period. The average age of a child in foster care is approximately **8** years old, with most placements occurring due to neglect, followed by **parental substance use and domestic abuse**.

For many children, foster care includes repeated transitions. Approximately **1/3** of children experience **two** or more placement changes, disrupting routines, relationships, and a sense of safety. These disruptions often extend into the classroom, where school changes and gaps in learning create additional barriers to success.

Nationally, only about **half** of youth in foster care graduate from high school on time, and fewer than **10%** enroll in college, with just **3 to 4%** earning a college degree. Frequent moves, trauma, and limited access to enrichment and academic support contribute to these outcomes.

Beyond academics, many children in foster care have **limited** access to everyday childhood experiences most children take for granted, such as participating in sports, attending birthday parties, joining clubs, or enjoying outings with peers. These missed opportunities for normalcy can affect confidence, connection, and long-term educational engagement.

In South Florida, children face additional risks. The region is recognized as a human trafficking **hotspot**, with trafficking cases among the highest in the state. A significant portion of those exploited are minors, reflecting the heightened vulnerability of children and youth who have experienced abuse, neglect, or instability.

For **15** years, **Voices** has worked to strengthen the safety net surrounding children in foster care by providing access to resources and enrichment, ensuring children have opportunities to learn, grow, and thrive, and helping remove barriers to education. Through advocacy, essential support, and experiences that promote stability and normalcy, **Voices** helps change outcomes for children across our community.

Community of Support

Voices is always ready to step in when children in foster care need support most. Thanks to philanthropic support, we are able to provide case management, advocacy, educational assistance, essential resources, and opportunities for normalcy at no cost to the children we serve.

Over the past **15** years, this purpose-driven work has been made possible through the dedication of our board, donors, volunteers, and a multidisciplinary team of experts who work every day to strengthen the safety net surrounding children in foster care.
